Top ten results for our athletes at the Australian All Schools Athletics Championships

Congratulations to all our athletes who competed at the Australian All Schools and recorded some wonderful results there.

Noah Hain, in his very first Australian Championships, won the bronze medal in the Under 14 Boys Long Jump event. The jump that earned the medal for Noah was 5.80 m. This leap by Noah broke the previous Club Record which had been set by Noah's brother, Sam. In his Triple Jump event Noah again produced a big effort on his last jump to leap up 3 places and take out the silver medal with his leap of 11.62m.

Harrison Wade finished in 4th place in the Under 18 Boys 3000 metres event in a personal best time (and Club Record) of 8 mins 49.20 secs.

Ben Nogajski finished 8th in the U16 Boys High Jump event with his clearance at 1.80m.

Sarah Playford finished 9th in the U16 1500m in a personal best time of 4 mins 48.45 secs.

Eliza Harvey finished 6th overall in the U16 800m in a pb time (and Club Record time) of 2 mins 11.70s. Eliza led from the start and went through the first lap in a time of 62.20s.

Madeline Playford placed 10th in the U14 Girls 1500m in a time just outside her personal best. Maddy's time was 5 mins 00.93 secs.

Johanna Volos finished 8th in the U18 Pole Vault with her successful clearance at 2.90m

Nicola Bowtell finished 5th in the U18 400m Hurdles event with her time of 65.22 seconds. Below Harrison's name up in lights and out on the track in the 3000m



Sarah placed 7th in the Senior Javelin with a throw of 29.71m. Sarah's team Abbotsleigh finished 4th overall. **Julia** competed for the Abbotsleigh Junior team in the javelin where she threw 28.58m to finish 8th and 9.16m in the shot put to again place 8th. Julia's Abbotsleigh team finished 6th overall.

Club and school mates **Breanna Ivankovic** and **Eliza Harvey** represented Loreto College Normanhurst in the Junior division where the team finished 9th overall. Eliza won the junior women's 800m in a time of 2m 13.95s and placed 11th overall in the Junior 100m. Breanna placed 24th in the 800m in a time of 2m 34.66s and 15th in 90m Hurdles in 16.42s. The girl's 4x200m relay team placed 8th in a time of 1m 51.97s.

Stephanie Volos picked up a silver medal as a member of the Pymble Ladies College intermediate team. Stephanie threw the javelin 23.29m to finish 11th.

Ben Nogajski put in a very strong performance for his school, Barker College in the Junior Boys who placed 13th overall. Ben finished with top points in the shot put with a throw of 13.50m and 6th in the 100m Hurdles in 16.25s. Barker's relay team placed 10th in 1m 41.76.


Nicola Bowtell also finished amongst the medal when her school, Pymble Ladies College finished 3rd in the Senior Girls competition. Nicola finished 6th in the 400m in a time of 59.87s and 9th in the 100m in 12.94s. Nicola's medley relay team won in 4m 10.60s.

Sisters **Elly & Jemma Gallagher** competed for the Mount Saint Benedict team in the intermediate division where their school finished 11th overall. Elly ran 13th in the 200m in a time of 27.03s and 18th in the 100m in 13.27s. Jemma finished 14th in the 800m in a time of 2m 25.02s. The relay team placed 9th in 2m 25.44s.

The All Schools Knockout is a great event to get your high school interested in. The qualifying State competition is run in August each year and the Nationals just after All Schools. If your son or daughter has a group of sporty friends that can cover jumps, throws, hurdles, sprints and middle distance then encourage their school to enter the competition next year. Round up with Ross Forster Treloar Shield

The 5th Treloar Shield Meet was held at Blacktown on Saturday, 28th November and we had a total of 16 athletes competing there.

Teresa Galati finished 6th in the Open Women's 100m Hurdles in a time of 17.50s. In her heat of the Open Women's 100 m event Teresa placed 7th with her time of 13.81s.

Amy Court placed 5th in her heat of the U16 Girls' 100m in a time of 13.43s. In her 200m heat Amy finished in 5th place with her time of 27.66 s. Amy finished in 16th place overall in the Open Women's Long Jump event with her leap of 4.45m.

Maya Leverett finished 3rd overall in the U18 Girls' 100m in a pb time of 12.56s. In her 200m heat Maya claimed 2nd spot in a time of 25.52s. Maya won the Open Women's Long Jump event with her leap of 5.51m.

Ben Cox (below) won heat 4 of the Open Men's 100m event with his time of 11.61s. In the Open Men's >5.5m Long Jump event Ben won with his leap of 6.85m.

The 6th Round of the Treloar Shield Meets was held at Campbelltown on Saturday, 5th December and we had a total of 6 athletes competing there.



Maya Leverett won the U18 Girls 100m event in a very fast time of 12.23s. Unfortunately she was assisted by a 4.1 m/sec tailwind. In her 200m Maya ran a personal best time (and National Qualifying time) of 25.07s.

Riley Leverett finished 3rd in his Triple Jump with a leap of 10.36m.

Lajos Joni won his 1kg Discus event with a throw of 33.56m. In his 600g Javelin event Lajos placed 2nd with his throw of 23.90m.

Ben Cox (below) placed 4th in his heat of the Open Men's 100m in a time of 11.42s. In the Open Men's Triple Jump event Ben finished in 2nd place with his leap of 14.77m.

Robert Hanbury-Brown won the 50-59 years 6kg Shot Put with a throw of 10.04m. In Discus Robert was again the winner with a throw of 34.86 m. Robert threw the 9.08kg Weight a distance of 13.22 m to also win this event.

Round 9 of the Northern Zone Competition was held at Rotary Field, Chatswood on 5th December and we were represented by 4 athletes.

Sue Gore won her 100m in a time of 16.6s. In her 1500m event Sue was again the winner in a time of 5m 49s.

Charlotte, Adam and Georgia all hit the track with 1500m records in mind and all achieved that goal. Well done.


Ryde Senior Championships Day 1


