ANNUAL REPORT AND FINANCIAL STATEMENT.

Presented at the Annual General Meeting  
on Monday 2nd May, 1983.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

This is the Twelfth Annual Report and a season which produced a record number of Registrations. Greater parent participation than ever before was therefore required. I would like to thank the Executive, Club committees and all other parents who assisted throughout the season.

The early part of the season proved very frustrating, without storage and canteen facilities. However the completion of our Clubhouse ( which we share with Penshurst West Youth Club) has made administration of Little Athletics much easier for all concerned.

The joint efforts of Hurstville Council, St. George Australian Football Club and Little Athletics, in maintaining Olds Park No. 1, produced in the latter part of the season, the best surface that we have competed on in our time at Olds Park. I am confident that if this co-operation continues improved track conditions will produce top performances more regularly.

Council approval has been received for the installation of two Shot circles and long jump run-ups. It is expected that these facilities will be completed before the start of next season.

The Centre was represented in the Trans Tasman competition and its members did well in Zone, Region and State Championships, winning nine individual medals and also the Gold medal in the 4 x 100m composite boys relay. Alex Gray was selected in the N.S.W. State Team which competed in Canberra at Easter.

Little Athletics has the motto "FUN RUNNING" and I trust the youngsters of St. George have enjoyed their events and achieved some personal goal which made their efforts worthwhile.

I wish the outgoing children good luck for the future and say thanks for being part of Little Athletics. To the remaining children I look forward to seeing you again next season.

### REGISTRATIONS

The Athletics season of 1982/83 saw an increase in registrations from 496 in 81/82 to a record 692 this season.

This was possibly due to the influence of the T.V. coverage of the Commonwealth Games in Brisbane, and the introduction of the Under 13 age group.

Registrations were taken on three afternoons prior to the commencement date, as well as most Friday nights throughout the season. Without the valuable assistance given to me by a number of ladies, the Lindwall girls, Michelle Zerzvadse and Jacinta Errington, this would have been an impossible task. Thanks girls!

The total number of athletes competing comprised 411 boys and 281 girls. These were divided by choice to the four Clubs of the St. George Centre. Next season we hope for a more balanced distribution to each Club.

### RECORDS AND RANKINGS.

The basis for issuing Merit Awards was to count the number of stickers issued prior to the Christmas recess for each age group, e.g. 9 weeks of competition with four events per week for the under 6,7,8 age groups, giving 36 events necessary to gain an award over the sixteen weeks of available competition from October 1982 till March 1983.

281 Merit Awards were issued out of a total registration of 691. This represents 41%, the second highest since the introduction of the system.

All records of the St. George Little Athletics Centre are awarded as per the guidelines of the International Amateur Athletics Federation (I.A.A.F.) This decision is the result of many hours discussion within the Executive Council of the Centre and previous Executive's statements on the matter.

McDonald's Achievement Awards were issued in the following manner:

- i) Accompanied each Merit Award. (281 issued)
- ii) Awarded to each athlete who competed in our Centre Championships and did not win a first, second or third medal in any event (103 issued).

### CHAMPIONSHIPS AND SPECIAL MEETINGS.

The State Road Walk Championships and the State Cross Country Championships were held on Sundays 11th and 18th July, 1982, at Nepean C.A.E. and Upjohn Park, Parramatta. The Centre was not very well represented but those athletes who did compete performed well.

Trans Tasman Trials were held at Hensley Athletic Field on Sunday 14th November, 1982. Ten U11 and U12 children competed in 50 events. Two U12 boys, Kurt Landers and Ian Herron, were successful in being selected in the N.S.W. Team. The Challenge Match was held in January and both boys competed very creditably with Kurt being placed 4th in the Discus, with a throw of 37.48m, being a member of the Gold medal winning Field Relay Team and also picking up a Silver medal in the 4 x 400m Track Relay. N.S.W. won convincingly by 396 points to 144.

STATE RELAY CHAMPIONSHIPS 5th December, 1982, Orana Pk; Campbelltown. Preparation for State Relays was hampered by the lack of key events early in the season, which made selecting teams very difficult. To avoid this happening in the future, I strongly recommend that these key events viz.; 100m, 400m, L.J., H.J., Shot and Discus, are given priority during the first six weeks of competition. This would allow coaches and athletes sufficient time to produce maximum results. However, in spite of this the Centre entered 42 of a possible 43 teams, with two teams winning medals and 15 other teams being in the final eight. Overall the Centre came 11th in the points score with a total of 33 points. The best result for a number of years.

The Under 12 boys 4 x 100m team won the Gold medal with the time of 53.2. Team members were: Alex Gray, Cameron Dean, Ian Herron, Greg Bunter and Brett Howell.

A Silver medal was won by the Under 13 boys 4 x 100m team in 52.6. Team members were: Tim O'Sullivan, Craig Bowden, Jason Mitchell and Alain Noisier.

ZONE SELECTION TRIALS were held at Olds Park on Sunday 12th December, 1982. The day was long and hot, the response poor, and all concerned in the long hours of preparation and actual running of the programme, felt the day was unnecessary and pointless. The resultant Zone Team could have been selected from results with a minimum of effort. In the future, I would like to see Zone by selection, with athletes nominating those events in which they would like to compete.

#### ZONE CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Having entered 173 competitors in 495 events in the Southern Metropolitan Zone Championships, held at Sylvania Waters Track on the 5th/6th February, 1983, the St. George Centre performed very well. This was an all time record number of entries. However, 57 events were not contested for various reasons by 30 competitors. Results were excellent, with 71 children qualifying in 139 events for Regional Championships.

There were some very pleasing results and several Zone Best Performances created by our athletes. The boys composite relay won their way to the Region in fine form. The team was: D. Bulian U10, R. Wallace U11, A. Gray U12 and A. Noisier U13.

The girls composite relay team also performed very well in running second. The team was: N. Wallace U10, M. Zerzvadse U11, S. Taylor U12 and A. Burgess U13.

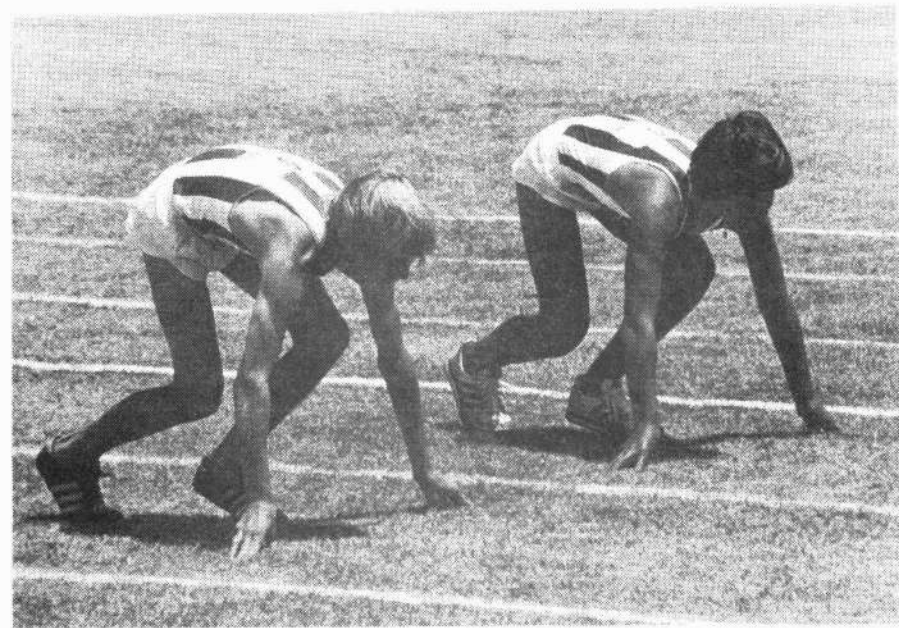
