

CENTRE CHAMPIONSHIPS:

299 children competed in the Centre Championships which were held at Olds Park on Sunday 4th March, 1984. This was slightly down on last years record number of 314. As there had been complaints re programming the previous year, efforts were made to rearrange the programme. The 200m Hurdles for Under 13 and all 1500m runs were held on Friday evening 2nd March. This proved to be a popular move and it certainly saved a lot of time on Sunday. However the day is still far too much for both athletes and officials and if Under 14s should be included in July, it will be impossible to run a full two day programme in one day. I strongly recommend that the Championships be held on two Sundays in March in the future regardless of what happens at the Conference.

STATE TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Held at Narrabeen Saturday/Sunday 17th/18th March 1984. Unlike the previous two State Championships, weather conditions were ideal. The Centre started the day in fine form being named March Past Champions for the third time in five years. A feat unmatched by any other Centre. Thirty athletes were successful in progressing to State Championships in 57 events. 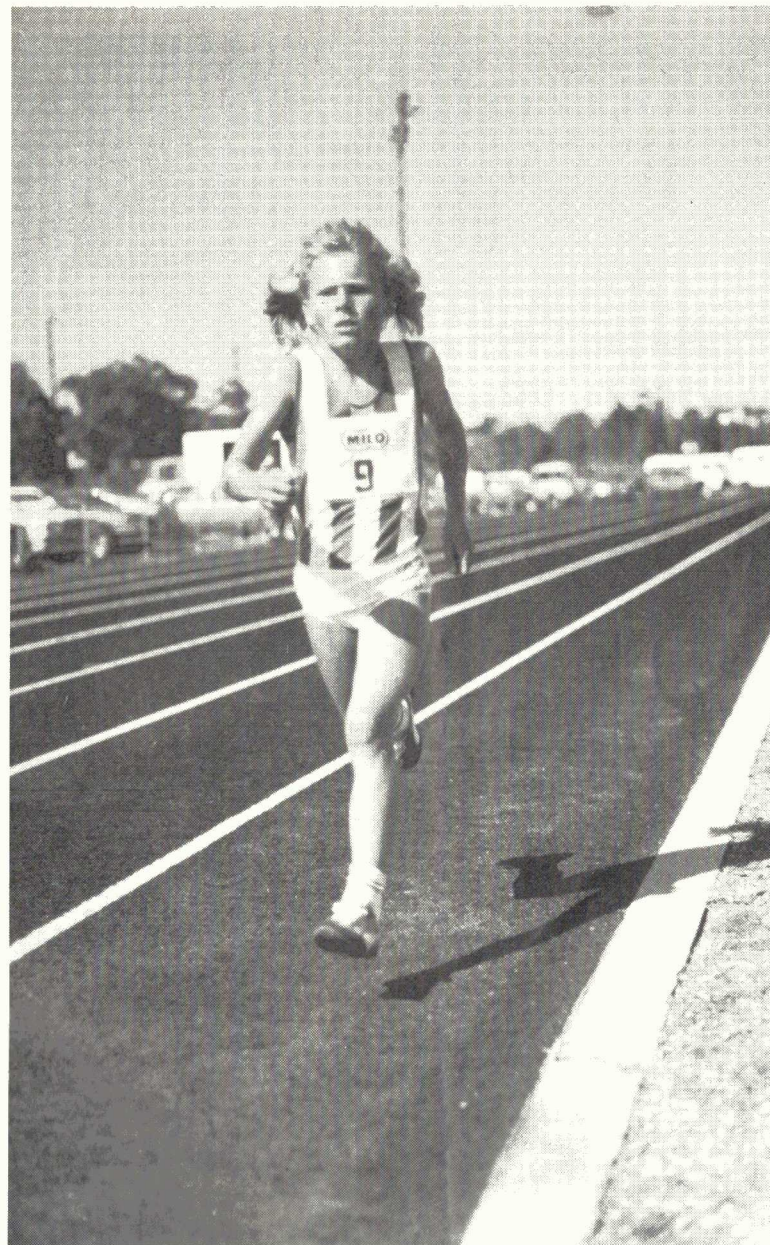

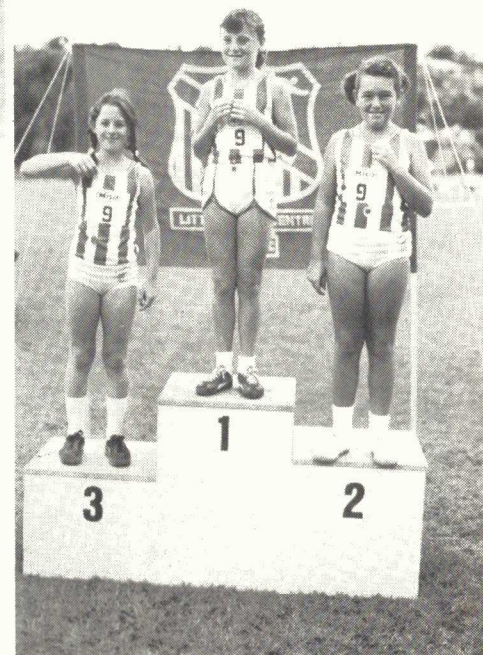
