It is my pleasure to reflect on the 1984/85 Athletic Season. This is the Fourteenth Annual Report and Financial Statement of the St. George Little Athletics Centre.

The Season started smoothly with the traditional ground marking working-bee. Registrations were the second highest ever recorded at St. George.

The Centre successfully ran or competed in the following:

St. G Centre C'ships, Ages 6, 7, 8 & 9, + Preston Ch. 9th Mar. 1985

L.A.A. State C'ships, 16/17th March 1985.

The St. George Centre successfully defended the Honey-Brenan Rosebowl Trophy against the Victorian Athletes from the Preston-Reservoir Centre.

Two outstanding achievements this year were Kylie Allen (U11 Girl) who was selected in the Trans-Tasman Challenge Team and Daniel Walker (U12 BOY) who was selected in the N.S.W. State Team of the L.A.A.

The Centre enjoyed a good working relationship with the Aldermen and Engineers' Department of the Hurstville Municipal Council. Ground repairs were carried out with minimal disruption to our activities. The long jump pit surrounds were replaced and the sand replenished. The H.M.C. accepted our flood lighting proposal for the shot and discus areas. The Council paid half the installation fee. It is also rumoured that the Blue Light Disco Committee run in conjunction with Hurstville Council is looking favourably at our request for reimbursement of our contribution. Thanks to our Patrons; Bev. and Fred Scott, foundation members for their continued support; Bill Hart of Surveying Equipment Company, Kingsgrove for his generous donation, tape repair service and supply of special marking paints; Les Poole of the Mortdale R.S.L. for the continued use of the Club for all our meetings.

The members of the Executive have been diligent in their duties, attending meetings and organising the Centre Activities. I personally thank the Members for their time and their initiative to implement their ideas.

I thank the Parents and Friends who contributed to the running of the Centre on Friday evenings. The Centre cannot operate without this participation. The regular weekly workers deserve special mention because it is their continued presence that enables the events to get going with a minimum of fuss. Special thanks to Gwen Taylor and Bill L'Estrange for their continued contributions, neither have children competing at our Centre.

One last thank you must go to Pat Watchorn, Margaret Zerzvadse and Dianne St. Baker for their wonderful contribution to the canteen. They formed a care-taker committee in the absence of a canteen manager and made a nett profit of about \$2,300.

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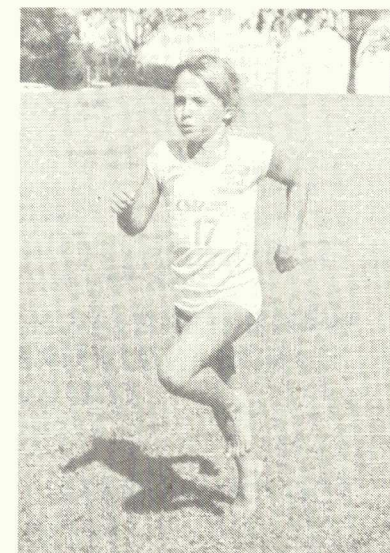
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#### COACHING

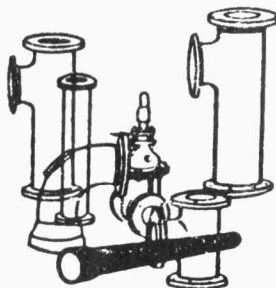


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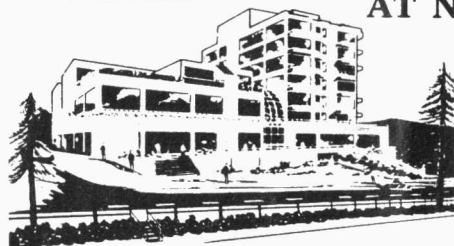
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### GROUND MAINTENANCE

On a social note it has been a good way to get to know the parents who are involved with the Centre and many new friends have been made.

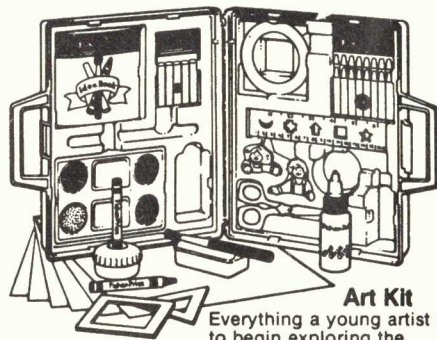

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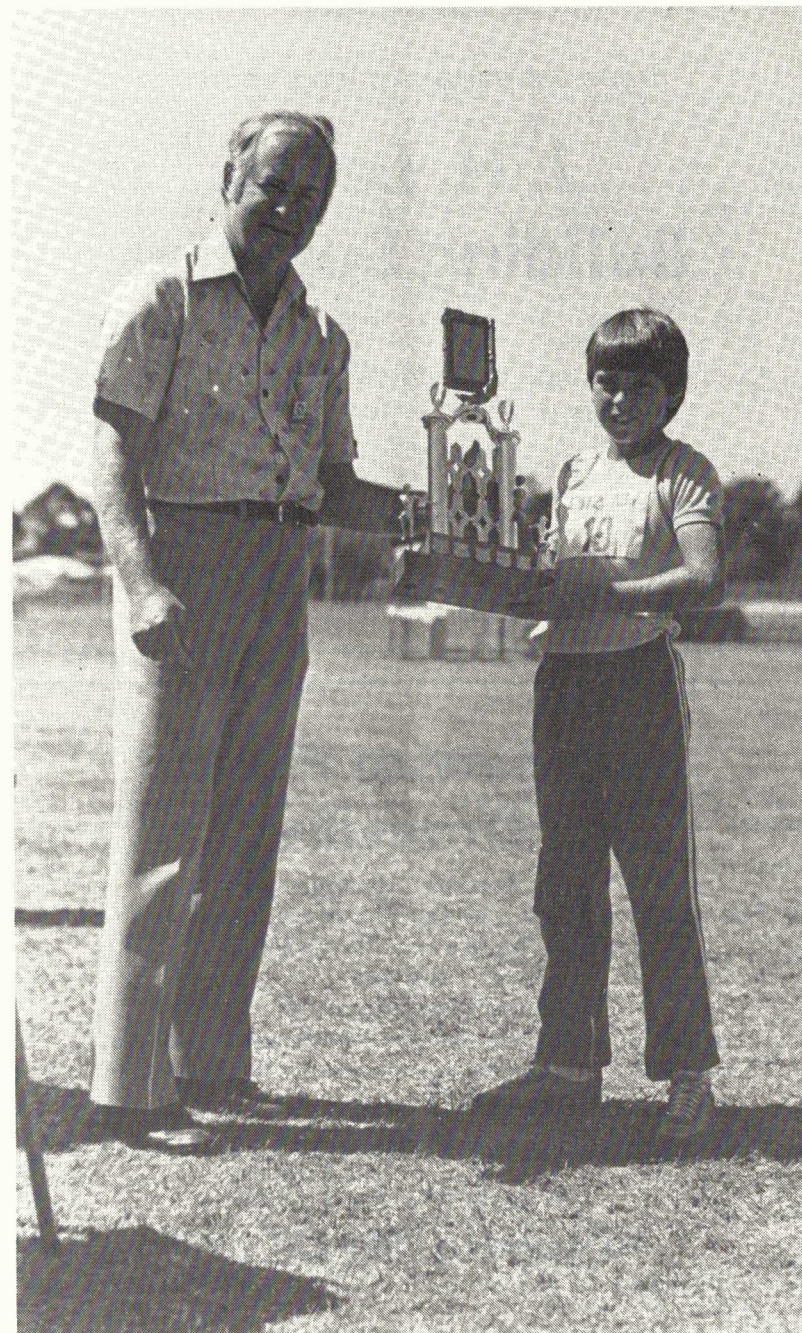


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### **RECORDS AND RANKINGS**
