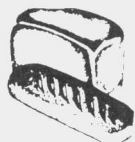

Toby Watson was awarded the "Leader's Sportstar" for winning 4 firsts at the Southern Metropolitan Regional Championships.

This year a team entered the State Age Championships. Rangers starred once again with Anthony McDermott winning Gold in the 400m and T.J., and breaking the State Record, also a Bronze in the 200m. John Romyn won Silver in the 800m, 1500m and H.J. Lisa Zammerrelli won Silver in the 1500m and a Bronze in the 800m. Karen Holgate ran 8th in the 1500m. Congratulations to our fine athletes.

Our Rangers representatives in the Trans Tasman held in New Zealand, starred again with David Romyn winning silver in the 800m and 5th in the 1500m and John Romyn won Gold in the 800m and ran 4th in the 400m. What a terrific effort
