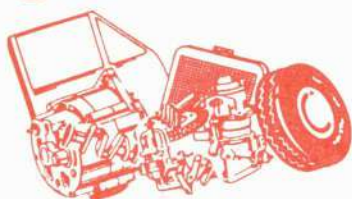

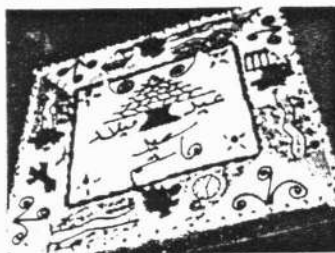

To all of our children who competed on Friday nights, at Zone, at Region or at State, Congratulations, you make it all worthwhile .

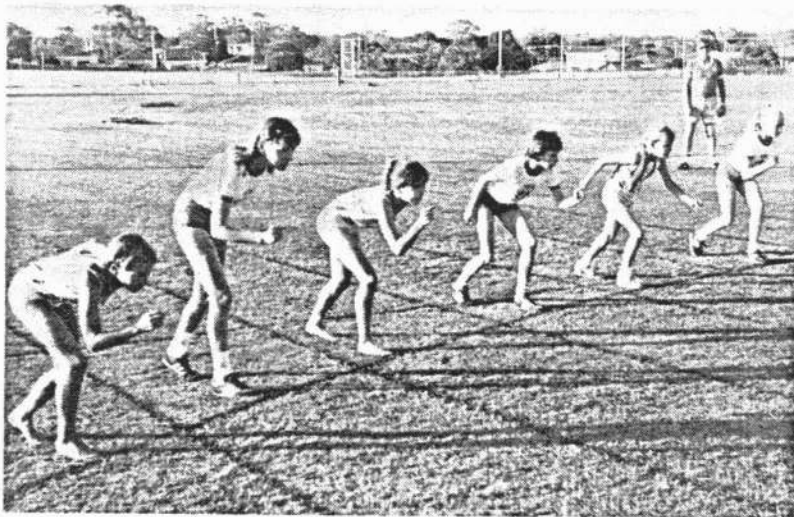

On the bright side this has been one of our most successful seasons for high jump. Sincere thanks are due to Bill Cruikshank Leigh Allen; George Foster; and Geoff Collins who gave up their Saturday mornings to coach 30 plus children for a couple of hours each week - three medals were brought home from the State titles because of the enthusiasm and encouragement shown to the kids each week by this group.

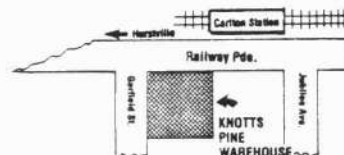
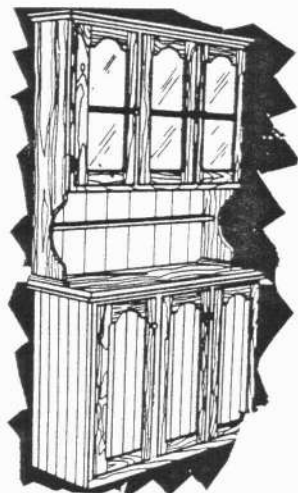
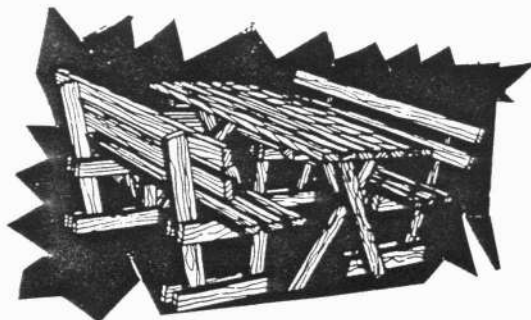
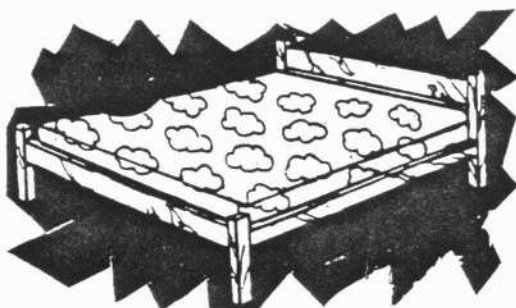
The highlight of last season was visits to Olds Park by coaches from the Little Athletics Association headed ably by John Quinn. Besides visiting six schools in the St. George area John conducted two twilight coaching sessions in November each session being attended by at least 70 children. John then returned in January and conducted four half day intensive coaching sessions more than 100 children attended these sessions each day - a marked improvement in personal best performances of all children who attended the clinic is proof of the success of the venture.

On the educational side St. George had six adults attend the Preliminary Coaching Clinic. A book and video coaching library is hoped to be commenced in the off-season for any interested parents and children.
