At the State Multi Championships Kimberlee came 1<sup>st</sup> with a new State Record in points scored, competing against 66 other competitors. At the State Relays carnival Kimberlee was a member of the U/12G's 4 x 100m gold medal winning team and also a member of the 4 x 400m mixed bronze medal team. During the season she also set Zone and St. George shot put records. Congratulations on a great season - the Centre is proud of you.

Taegan is a genuine all round athlete who has broken a lot of our U/15 girls records this season. At the State Multi Competition she came 5<sup>th</sup> against the strongest field for many years. At Zone Taegan gained 3 gold and 1 silver. At Region 2 gold and 2 bronze. At State Taegan gained a bronze medal in the javelin and represented in 3 other events. At Zone Taegan set High Jump and Javelin records. St. George records were set for High Jump, Javelin, Discus and Shot Put. Total registrations for the Centre declined by approximately 80 on the previous season. However, it must be noted that the previous season's total was attributable to it being an Olympic year. This season's total of 518 is comparable with the 1995-96 season's total of 513.

It is interesting to note that normally the boys outnumber the girls at our centre. This season however registration numbers were equal.

This season also saw a significant increase in new family registrations. Normally they are approximately 30% of total registrations, but they increased to 50% this season.

## 11TH TRANS TASMAN TOUR

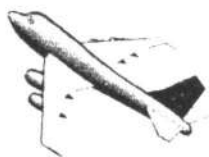

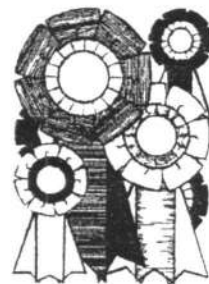

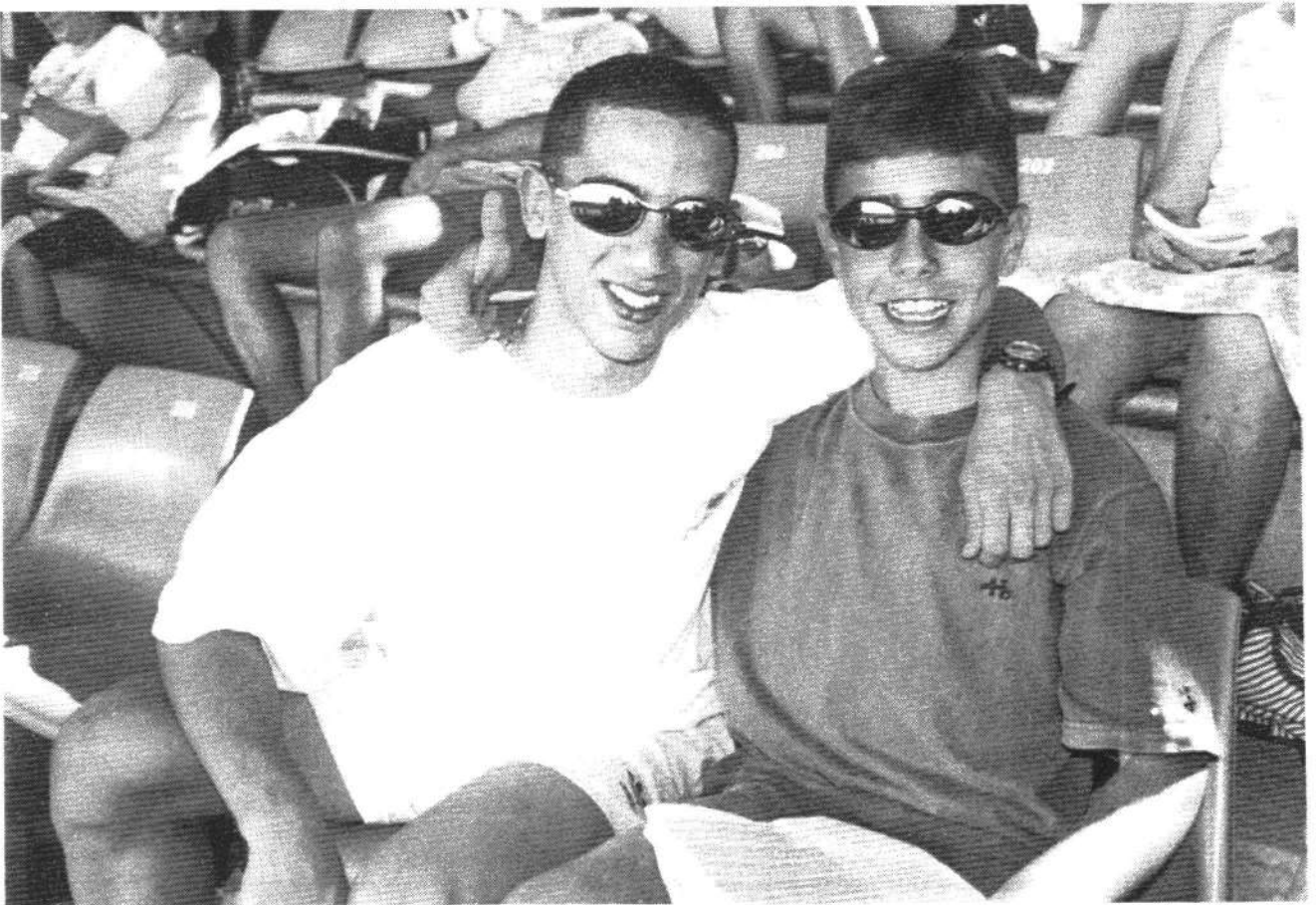
