RECORDS AND RANKING REPORT

Congratulations to all St George athletes – their continual improvement in their ability has kept me extremely busy this season as I attempt to keep our Records up to date.

I wish to thank Roger Malcolm for his continued assistance in refining our Athletics Computer Program and for beginning the production of a Procedural Manual for future users as the process is the heads of a few at this time. Thankyou also to Shayne and Angela for cutting and filing the hundreds of stickers each week.

This year a total of 79 Ground Records were broken. I would especially like to mention here three athletes Gregory Koliopoulos who broke 14 records, Adam Fitzgerald (11) and Christopher Barakat (10). There are a number of Straight Track Records as this is the first year following the use of our gates with automatic timing. A total of 31 Centre Records were also broken with several athletes breaking their own records as they progressed through Zone and Region to State.

Unfortunately I can only record the best result in my report, however each athlete who broke a record has a Record Certificate. It is pleasing to see that records were broken across a large range of disciplines, sprints, walks, hurdles jumps and throws.

Highlights of his time with the Centre are:

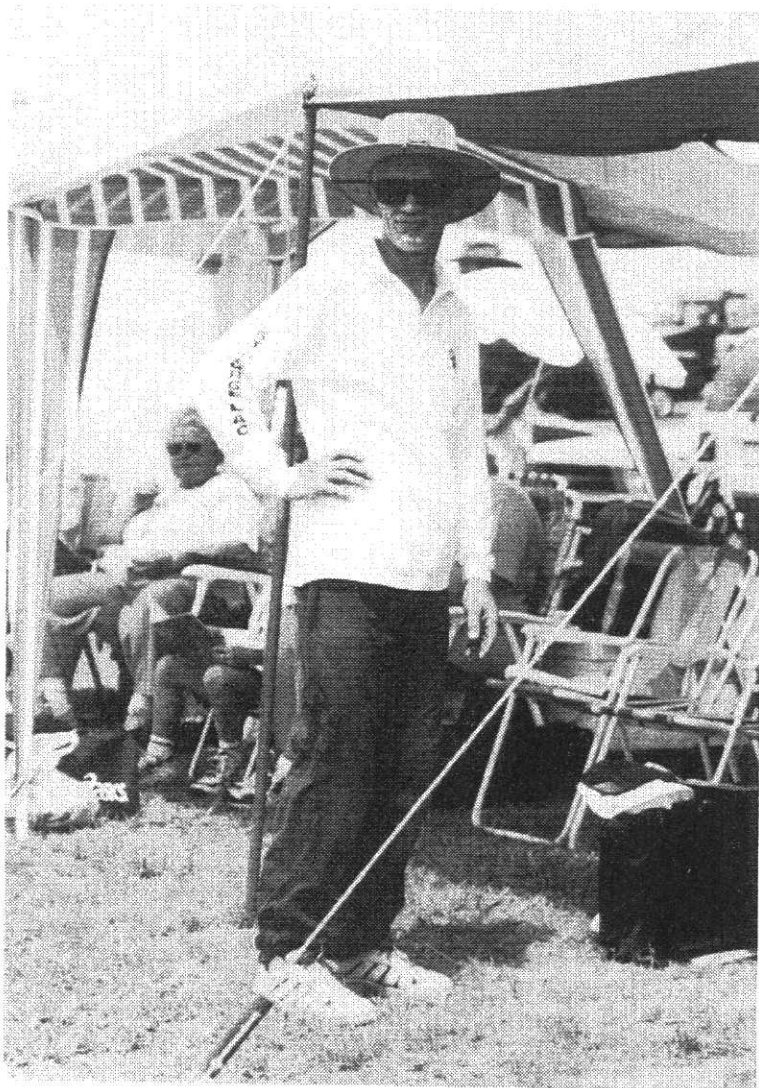
- 1987-1990 Timekeeper/Chief timekeeper Circular Track (200m/400m Finish)
