REGISTRAR'S REPORT

While several years experience in this position has made the volume of paperwork easier to cope with, the beginning of the season never ceases to challenge me. Our two registration nights this season were particularly hectic with almost 300 registrations being accepted.

I wish once again to express my gratitude to the members of the executive who assisted me on these nights, with special mention to Alex Oh for his continued support whilst registrations continued during the ensuing weeks .

Our total registrations for this season have increased overall by 123 on the previous season, with almost all age groups registering an increase. Perhaps this is attributable to the lead up to the Sydney 2000 Olympics. Similar registration numbers were recorded in the year of the 1996 Atlanta Olympics.

Last season saw registrations of girls outnumber boys. That trend has not continued with the boys back in front by a slight number. Once again this season has seen an increase in the number of new registrations to just under 60%. Over the past three seasons the percentage of new registrations has almost doubled.

TRANS TASMAN CHALLENGE, AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND (13 January, 2000 to 25 January, 2000)

Trials were held on 7 November, 2000 at the Sylvania Waters track. Two of our U11 athletes, Melissa Gorman and Tim Radley, were selected in the team to represent NSW against Auckland, in the Trans Tasman Challenge in Auckland, New Zealand.

The Trans Tasman Challenge is an annual event with the NSW team touring New Zealand bi-annually. The Auckland team tours to NSW in the alternate years. This is open to U11 and U12 athletes only from NSW Little A's. This enables the children to be involved in a tour to NZ one year and hosting the Auckland team in NSW another year. The tour is conducted through Little Athletics NSW. The aim of the tour is to provide childrens athletics with emphasis on enjoyment of participation and personal achievement and is educational with exposure to people of another country, their customs and general environment in which they live.

In this years tour to NZ, as well as enjoying the NZ scenery, athletes from NSW competed at four Zone carnivals at Pakuranga, North Harbour, Tauranga, Papakura and of course, the Trans Tasman Challenge Match at Mt. Smart Stadium, which was previously used for the Auckland Commonwealth Games.

Melissa and Tim both performed at a high standard at the Trans Tasman Challenge and were a credit to the St George Centre and the NSW Team.

Melissa competed in 100m, 200m, 400m, long jump and 4 x 100m relay.

Melissa progressed to the final in all her events and brought home 1 gold medal in the 200m and 1 silver medal in the 4 x 100m relay. Results were: 200m - 1st - 30.5, 4 x 100m - 2nd - 1.00.19, 100m - 4th - 15.51, Long Jump - 6th - 3.74m & 400m - 7th - 1.10.94 - personal best. Tim competed in 100m, Discus, Shot Put & Field relay. Tim performed exceptionally well and brought home a silver medal in the field relay. Results were: Field relay - 2nd, Discus - 13th - 19.92m, Shot Put - 15th - 7.81m & 100m - unfortunately did not make the final but recorded a personal best time. Congratulations to Matthew Gorman, an U8 athlete, (Melissas' younger brother), also competed in the four zone carnivals. He competed in 14 events overall with six 1st placings, four 2nds and four 3rds. Matthew also achieved a number of personal bests.

Two of our parents, Patrick Gorman and Liz Radley, also travelled with the team as section Managers. Janet and Matthew Gorman also attended as supporters. An interesting and enjoyable time was had by all.

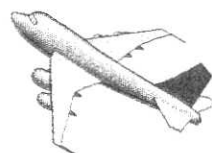

RECORDS AND RANKING REPORT

Congratulations to all St George athletes – their continual improvement in their athletic ability has again kept me extremely busy this season. Our athletes continue to create new ground and centre records.

This year I was unable to produce stickers for weekly event results after Christmas as our computer finally decided it had had enough, 594 athletes and their weekly results were too much for the system to handle. I wish to thank Roger Malcolm for his invaluable advice in the purchase of our new computer. The new computer will enable us to make more efficient use of time – I expect us to be able to enter our results on Friday nights during competition.

This year a total of 68 Ground Records were broken. I would especially like to mention here three athletes who broke records across three different athletic events. Christopher Barakat, 100m, 90m and 100m hurdles, Gregory Koliopoulos, discus, javelin and shot put and Kristie Pemberton, 80m hurdles, long jump and javelin. A total of 25 Centre Records were also broken with several athletes breaking their own records as they progressed through Zone and Region to State.

Unfortunately I can only record the best result in my report, however each athlete who broke a record has received a Record Certificate. It is pleasing to see that records were broken across all disciplines, sprints, walks, long distance, hurdles jumps and throws.

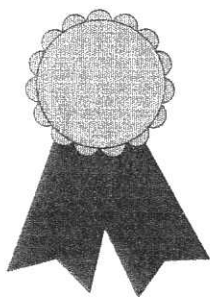

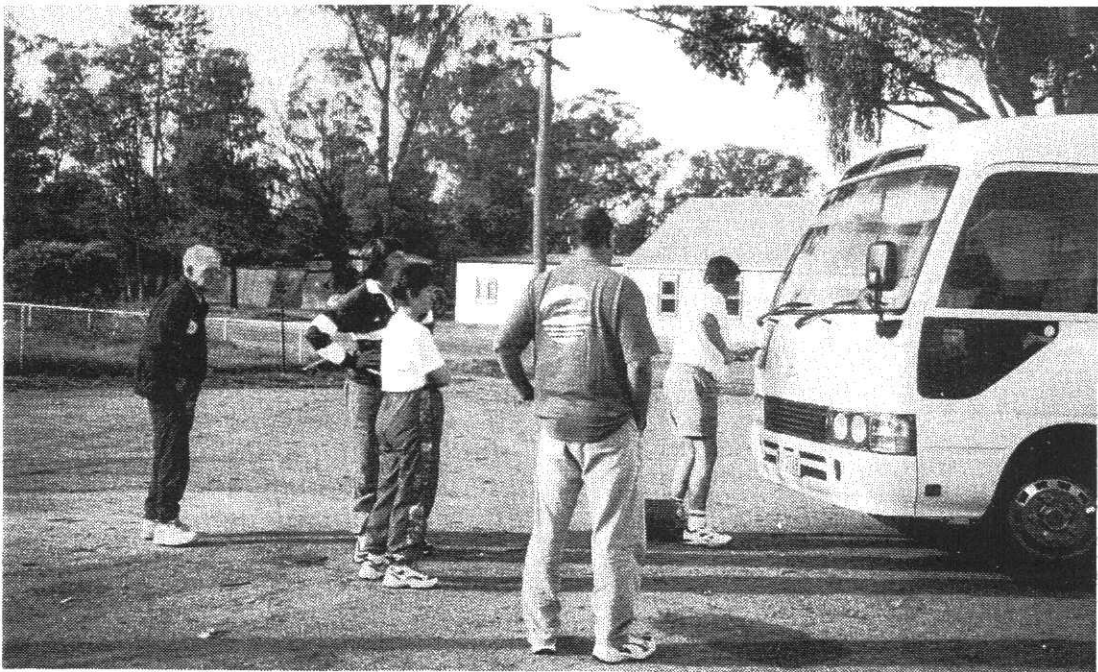

John is also always at Zone to set up the equipment at 6.00am in the morning and always helps chasing up parents who are needed for official duties.

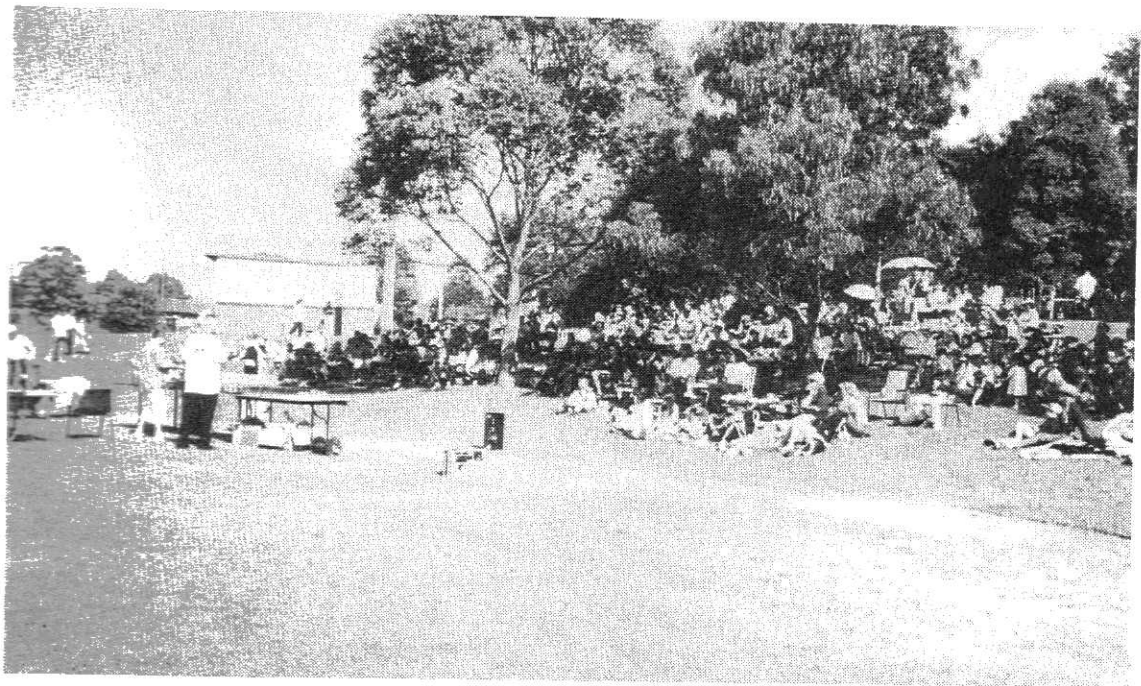
John is also in charge of organising and marking our track and I'm sure that those who have helped him out over the years have lots of fun stories to tell of their experiences in marking the track.

John is a very worthy recipient of Life Membership.

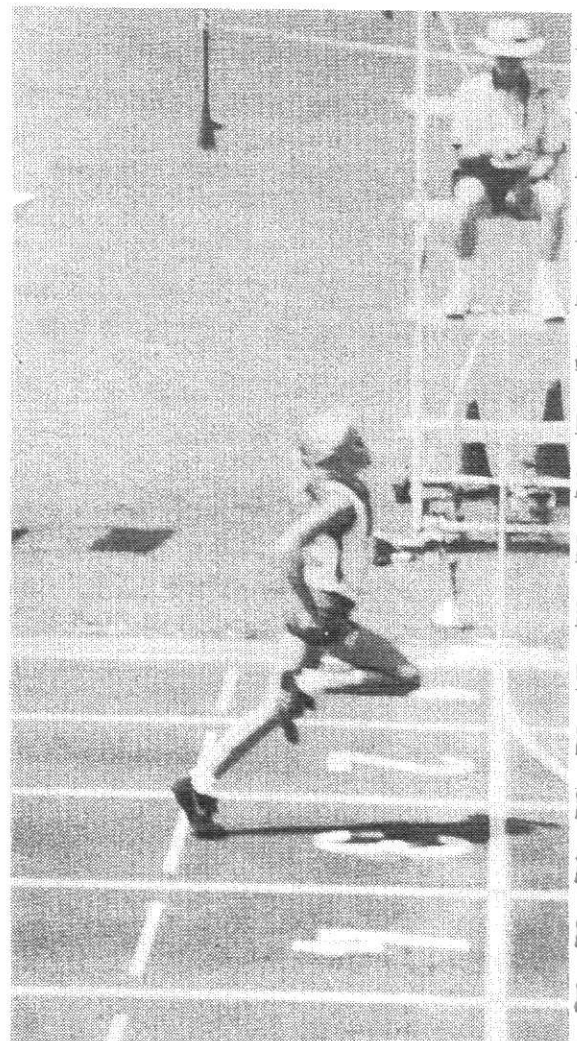


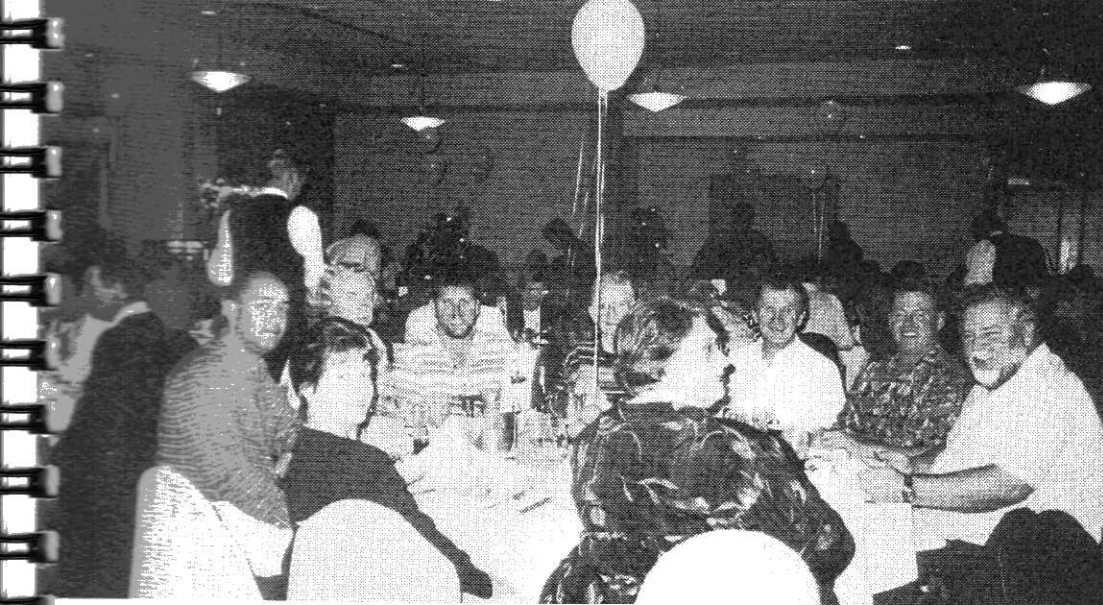

jump and run?*

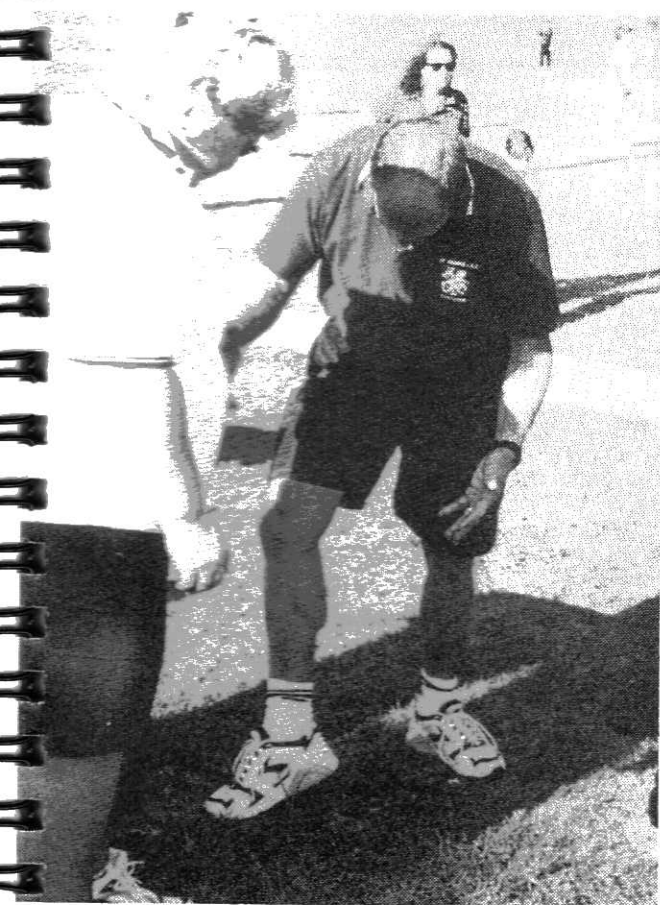
