

# **ST. GEORGE CENTRE MULTI-NIGHT** **(Friday 12th January, 2001)**

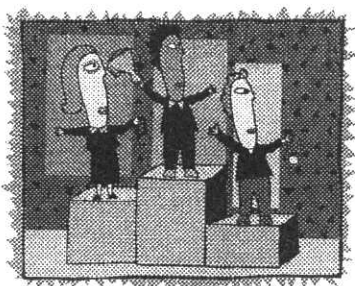

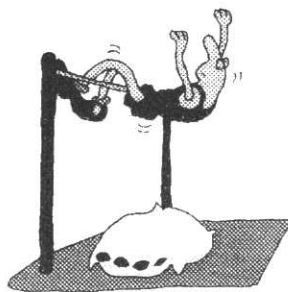
We had 237 athletes compete at Zone – 113 girls and 124 boys.
