## **RECORDS & RANKING REPORT**

Congratulations to all St George athletes – their continual improvement in their athletic ability and enthusiasm in this sport has again kept me extremely busy this season. Our athletes continue to get stronger and faster and consistently create new ground and centre records. Once again I experienced some minor computer mal functions but after consultation with our computer technician, Roger Malcolm, we were back on track again.

This year a total of 29 Ground Records and 6 Centre Records were broken. I would especially like to mention 5 athletes who broke more than one record each this season and whose general performance was outstanding.

Luke Hamer (U12B), 100m, 200m and 400m. Luke broke 4 ground records and 3 centre records. Luke had a sensational season as he progressed through from Centre to State level and set a new State Record in the 400m.

Alice losefo (U10G) had a very productive season in the field with the Shot Put and Discus breaking 7 Ground Records and also claiming herself a new State Record in Shot Put. She seemed to come back each week and throw further than the previous week consequently, breaking her own records.

Two very strong, young athletes, Leiden Kronemberger (U15G) and Grace Lister (U13G), broke records in the 80mH and 200mH and young gun Naomi Lopez (U9G) broke the 70m and 100m records.

Unfortunately I can only record the best result in my report, however, each athlete who broke a record has received a Record Certificate. It was pleasing to see that records were broken across a number of disciplines but sprints, hurdles and throws this year were given a thorough work out.

## **TRANS TASMAN TOUR – 2004**

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of January 2004, a team of New South Wales athletes traveled to New Zealand to compete for the Trans-Tasman Challenge Cup.

This competition is for athletes in the U11 and U12 age groups. This year a team of approximately 140 athletes left for what is for some an experience of a lifetime. That is to compete overseas for your state and experience the sights and cultures of another country.



This year saw four St. George athletes selected to travel with the team to New Zealand and represent NSW Little Athletics. Those athletes were Matthew Gorman, Alexander Hinson, Rebecca Nelson and Alyssa Parkinson.

Alexander and Matthew had both been part of the NSW team which competed in NSW against New Zealand when the New Zealand team traveled to Australia last year. Pat Gorman and I also traveled with the team as Section Managers.
