ANNUAL REPORT AND FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Presented at the Annual General Meeting
on Tuesday 27th May, 1975

It gives me considerable pleasure to present this, the Fourth Annual Report of the St George Little Athletics Centre. I would firstly like to thank all the members of the Executive for their untiring efforts during the past season. It would probably not be fair of me to name individual members of the Executive, however I must mention Nola Magnay and Keith Dowsett for the amount of work they do. Nola and Keith, please accept both my personal thanks, and also the thanks of all the members on a job so expertly done.

Highlights of the season were the improving standard of the children, the success of our annual competition against the Preston-Reservoir Centre for the second year in a row, the selection of Jenny Ironside and Michael Heid in the N.S.W. squad, and last but by no means least the appointment of Mrs Beverley Scott to the position of Manageress of the N.S.W. team.

While the above comments must give us all a great deal of satisfaction, I feel a word of warning must be given. A lot more effort must be put in by the parents to alleviate the work load that has been carried by the same group of people over the past few years. If this does not happen, it could lead to a decline in the standard of efficiency displayed by the Executive, that is to be elected at this meeting.

In conclusion, may I say to all those children who competed in the season just ended, a hearty Well Done! I hope you all enjoyed the competition, because that will be reward enough for those people who worked so hard in their various jobs.

REGISTRATIONS

A total of 284 children were registered during the season, which was 101 less than last year. The distribution of the children through the clubs was as follows :

Although all schools in the area were issued with information regarding Little Athletics, it is apparent that not all schools and teachers co-operated in informing the children.

EQUIPMENT

This season started with the marking of the ground and was done in very quick time. Once the pegs, put down last season, had been located, and with some willing workers and two marking machines, it was easily completed. One machine was supplied by Rangers Soccer Club. Our thanks go to Hurstville Council for their co-operation in letting us use part of the amenities block as a storage shed for our equipment and for supplying us with a power outlet in the shed for the P.A. system. During the season two more throwing circles were constructed by Council for discus and shot put. Many thanks go to Lugarno Sports Club for the use of the P.A. system again, and also to the ladies who made the covers for the high jump bags.

Equipment purchased this year included 2 long jump metre boards, 2 starting pistols, 6 high jump bags, 1 reel, shot puts etc. Next season some of the equipment still required includes loud hailer, marking machine, duplicator, typewriter, etc.

Many thanks to Mrs D.Coutts for making a shed in her yard available for the storing of the equipment during the off season.

I wish to thank the many people who helped me during the season, without whose help the marking of the track, and the setting up of the field each week would have been impossible.

OFFICIALS

Again this season the job of running events at Centre level was left to the same few parents every week. On several occasions events were almost cancelled because of the lack of workers to run the event, but parents soon came forward because they realised that their child would have missed out on one of his/her events. Why did you, the parent, not come forward in the first place? Answer unknown.

When officials were required for higher levels of competition, Zone and State Championships, St George's small quota was filled, as usual by the same few hardworking parents who are interested in promoting Little Athletics for all children, and not just their own.

In the coming season, the only request to parents is - come forward to help, each day of competition, and the events will be run a lot easier. The sooner you the parents come forward to work the easier becomes the job of the Officer for Officials.

MERIT AWARD

The Merit Award system was continued again during the 1974-75 season in order to encourage attendance and participation by both the average athlete and the champion. Again it was arranged so that when the first awards were presented the week after the Christmas break, it required participation in every event on every competition day to earn the award.

This meritorious performance was achieved by four boys and one girl - Gregory Scott (U8 - who incidentally gained the first Merit Award last year), Matthew Avery (U8), Stephen Banner (U12), Peter Banner (U9) and Carolyn Banner (U10), all of whom are with the Arncliffe Club.

By the end of the season, 76 children had gained their Merit Awards.

INTERCLUB REPORT

Firstly I must say a very interesting season is now over. What with changes in starting times and visitors from other Centres, competition was very keen.

Programmes went off rather well, although at times I felt for the children when their events were cancelled through lack of helpers. To those parents who did help our officials each week, my most grateful thanks.

The grading system was again used during the season. All children were graded in every event, and the grading lists were updated each week by a small group of helpers. In this way each child was given the chance to compete against others of equal ability. With a few small exceptions the system ran smoothly and should be continued next season.

The pointscore system for the interclub competition was again changed during the past season. Each child who competed scored points for their club;; these points were then totalled and divided by the number of children competing each day. The competition presentations were made on the final day of the season, with the results as follows :

Thus the Best Boys Team, Best Girls Team and the Interclub Competition Trophies were won by the Rangers Club, each for the first time.

FUND RAISING AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

The season got off to a good start financially following donations received from various business houses in the area, as a result of requests sent out by John Seckold.

The canteen operated smoothly with willing helpers usually available when required. Barbecues were held successfully at the twilight meetings, with both parents and children availing themselves of the tempting goods offered. Total canteen profit of \$402.86 up to 23.1.75 was due to John Seckold's untiring efforts prior to his resignation.

The last six weeks of canteen trading raised \$136. This period was marred by very bad weather, resulting in the abandonment of one meeting and poor attendance at several others.

The Preston children, officials and parents accompanying the team were the guests of the St George Centre and their barbecue meal was provided out of canteen funds. Fortunately the entire canteen stock was used or sold at the end of the season.

COACHING

The attendance of children at training sessions was good in the first couple of months of the season, but after the Christmas break it was very disappointing to see so few children attend the coaching classes.

Many congratulations to the children who did so well at the Zone and State Championships.

PUBLICITY

"Action", our weekly newsheet, proved a worthwhile publication as all members and parents were kept informed of happenings within the Centre and at club level. The four clubs used it as a means of communication with their members, whilst at the same time it was an added method of fund raising. When space permitted, articles appeared in the "Leader", but not as often as we would have liked.

CROSS COUNTRY 1974

This season a circuit programme was introduced with six venues. St George was represented by a handful of competitors, but these boys and girls really surpassed themselves with exceptional performances. St George is hoping to be a host for a Cross Country and Road Walking Gala Day in 1975.

CROSS COUNTRY AND ROAD WALKING CHAMPIONSHIPS OF N.S.W.

The N.S.W. Cross Country and Road Walking Championships were held at Upjohn Park, Parramatta on Sunday, 25th August, 1974.

Our most successful competitor was Under 9 boy Wayne Wetherall, who for the second successive year won his race. This season Team Championships were re-introduced and it was most gratifying to find every St George Team gaining a place. We received 4 first placings, 3 second placings and 1 third placing.

Mark Hammon set a record in the 400m of 1.06.3.

Darren Scott Under 11, set a record in the discus with a throw of 26.48m.

Craig Bailey flew in the final leg of the 4 X 100m relay - he was clocked at 13.5, an outstanding run.

Jacquelin Magnay, competing as an Under 12 in the 1500m Walk, slashed our record with a superb 8.56.0.

Marilyn Stone Under 12 continued to demolish our Shot Put record to win with 9.67m.

Michael Heid, Under 12, again gave us a Discus record with 31.36m. Ground records were set by every St George Relay Team - a fantastic performance.

Apart from St George children setting records some of our guests gave us Open Ground Records.

S. Foley set an Open Ground Record in the Under 11 60m Hurdles of 10.1.

M.Kazuro (the Australian Record holder), set an Open Ground Record of 29.08m in the Under 11 Boys Discus, whilst B.Davey Under 12 boy set a discus record of 33.00m.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

The N.S.W. State Championships were held at Hensley Athletic Field, Pagewood, on Saturday and Sunday 22nd and 23rd March, 1975.

In the words of the Little Athletics Secretary-Manager, Mr. Peter Shinnick who so aptly described the Championships - "In weather conditions never before experienced by the Association at its two day meeting, the spectacle of magnificent performance of enthusiastic participation, of understanding and proficient officials, together with an enthusiastic sundrenched crowd of spectators, it may go on record as being the best athletic carnival conducted in this State for quite some time."

In two days of records crashing as never before, we were indeed fortunate to gain 7 first placings, 2 second placings and 5 third placings.

Our most outstanding performance at the Championships was that of Under '12 girl, Jennifer Ironside, who apart from winning two gold medals, set a new State Record in the 100m of 12.6 and equalled the record in the 200m with a superb 26.7.

STATE SQUAD

A Little Athletics Squad consisting of 27 girls and 25 boys has been chosen on the results of the State Championships and the four Top Twelve Meetings held during the season. From the Squad a team of 22 children will be chosen after 27th July to represent N.S.W. at the Australian Teams Championships in Perth on 31st August, 1975. St George was fortunate in having Jennifer Ironside and Michael Heid chosen in the Squad.

We wish them well in their selection trials and hope they will join with Sandra Perry (1973-74 State Representative) and Andrew Scott (1972-73 State Representative) in keeping St George to the fore at interstate level.

N.S.W. TEAM MANAGERESS

Mrs Beverley Scott, from our Centre, was appointed Manageress of the N.S.W. team for the second successive year. The N.S.W. team was to have competed at the Australian Teams Championships in Darwin next August, however the venue was altered to Perth due to the unfortunate destruction by Cyclone Tracey.

Mrs Scott's appointment was announced at the end of October, 1974, so that together with the Team Manager, Mr Brian Melene of the Hornsby Centre, they would have the opportunity of meeting Under 12 boys and girls throughout the season, both at Top Twelve Meetings and other Championship Meetings.

CONCLUSION

There were three resignations received from Executive members during the season, but fortunately capable replacements were found for all positions, so the Centre did not suffer in this regard.

Unfortunately the truck which had acted as canteen and storage space for equipment had to be disposed of, as it was uneconomical to have it repaired. The Executive decided to purchase a caravan for conversion into a canteen, but to date no suitable vehicle has been found.

The Centre did its share of work in assisting with the organisation of the Little Athletics Association of NSW during the past season. Officials were supplied whenever requested, and two people played a very active role - Beverley Scott as NSW Team Manageress, and Fred Scott who served on the Board of Management as Officer for Officials, Technical and Equipment. St George delegates have attended every Association meeting. Also the Darwin Little Athletics Appeal was supported, which will help to re-establish the sport in Darwin.

Kogarah Council is to be congratulated on the proposed athletic field to be constructed at Blakehurst. Although an all-weather track is planned for the future, to begin with a grass track is to be laid. Let us hope that the dream becomes a reality, as first class athletic facilities are sadly lacking in the St George area. With the boost that this will provide, the numbers participating in the sport can only improve, both in Little Athletics and the Mens and Womens Clubs.

In conclusion, the past season has been most successful, both with regard to the results of championships and the more important function of providing a healthy recreation for the children of St George. The outgoing Executive is very grateful for the willing co-operation received from the clubs and the parents, and trusts that this will be similarly extended to the incoming Executive.
