Competition was, as usual, very keen between the clubs, perhaps being a reason so many new records were set, and the children are to be commended on the true friendship and sportsmanlike manner in which they competed.

The grading system was once more successful and may I express my personal thank you to that small band of people, who each week took home the results and worked so hard sorting out each age group.

Unfortunately, owing to rain and long grass etc., some events had to be altered e.g. 200m to 100m, but not to be undaunted the children still competed to the best of their ability.

A new club, Mortdale R.S.L., was formed this season, and although they suffered a few teething problems, will be a force to be reckoned with in the future.

It is difficult to pin-point the reasons we are not gaining more members, but it is obvious that Sunday meetings are not popular in some cases.

EQUIPMENT

Another successful season has just concluded. During this season we purchased several new items of equipment which included a portable loud hailer and two long jump markers. On the other hand several pieces of equipment were lost, including one 30m fibreglass tape, two 1kg shot puts and a 750gm and 500gm discus.

Equipment damaged during the season and in need of repair or replacement include long jump boards, high jump bags, stakes and all stop watches to be tested. Discus, shot put markers, long jump boards and a P.A. system need to be purchased.

Many thanks to Lugarno Sports Club for the loan once again of their P.A. System, without which we could not have functioned as successfully, the people who helped in marking out the track at various times during the year and the few "old faithfuls", who each Sunday would help cart the equipment to its various locations and then assist in the repacking.

### OFFICIALS

Unfortunately, as usual, this job was left to the same old faces each week. If all parents were prepared to put in one afternoon every three weeks, instead of letting their children walk to Evatt Park or watch from their umbrellas, then everyone would have a chance to watch their own children competing.

There was a good response for officials at the two Top 12 meetings and our two day trip to Campbelltown for the Zone Championships, but unfortunately they were a little harder to find for the State Titles.

On behalf of all the competitors, I would like to thank the parents who did help out each week, or now and again, and especially the gentleman, who each week officiated and did not have any children competing.

### MERIT AWARD

Once again the Merit Award system was conducted, and proved to be as popular as ever. A total of 98 Merit Awards were presented during the season, which is a very high percentage of registered members.

Four children gained their Merit Award on the first day after the Christmas break by recording 100% attendance and participation. They were - Peter McMann (U7) from Lugarno, Joanne Price (U8) from Lugarno, Gregory Scott (U9) from Arncliffe (for the third successive year), and Caroline Banner (U11) from Arncliffe (for the second successive year).

### PUBLICITY

The weekly "Action" newssheet kept the five clubs, parents and all members informed on the happenings and various social events throughout the season.

Personally, I would like to see the clubs use the "Action" more often for advertising their social functions and general information on their competitors, etc.

Unfortunately, all the articles submitted to the "Leader" were not published, evidently owing to lack of space.

### FUND RAISING & SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

The Centre benefited by \$1381.12 from the fund raising activities during the 1975-76 season.

The canteen and raffles were again successful, raising a total of \$558.07. All canteen stock was sold and one monkey remains to begin raffles next season. While on the subject of the canteen, it is felt that the work load should be more evenly shared by all clubs in the Centre. Thank you to the clubs which operated the canteen for a few weeks after Christmas, as the break was very welcome.

The "200Club" was fortunately a financial success raising \$221.75 -subscriptions being \$269.75 and prizes totalling \$48.00. This method of financing could have been costly if the final prize of \$250.00 had been won. In future years any method such as this must have greater financial support from all parents.

The games night was very successful considering the short notice given to this function being held. A profit of \$615.30 resulted. Games nights are quite obviously the most successful method of fund raising and it is recommended that two such functions be organised each season in future years.

### COACHING

It was very pleasing to see a good attendance at training on Tuesday afternoons. I am sorry that I cannot give more individual attention to any one child, but time will not allow it. Thank you to the parents who assisted me in this past season.

Congratulations to the children who competed successfully at Zone and State Championships, and especially to Jacquelin Magnay who gained selection in the State Team.
